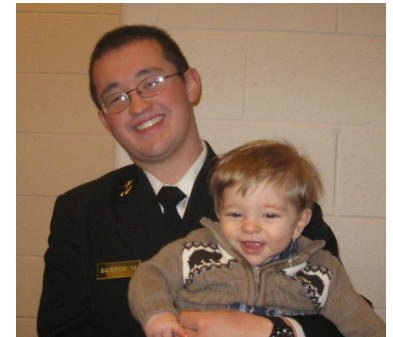

This Lent I have been offering the students a weekly teaching on the LORD'S PRAYER at our Presanctified Liturgies served at the St. John's Boathouse, which is an opportunity for them to invite their friends. The midshipmen too are invited and encouraged to attend—the Boathouse is just across the street from the Academy.

Among the many ministry activities since our last newsletter are the following:

- The 2013 March for Life in Washington, D.C., an opportunity to stand for the value of each human life even as we pray for the victims of abortion.

- The 6th Hour is prayed twice weekly at the Naval Academy.
- Weekly Vespers at St. John's (outside Lent) and Wednesday Presanctified Liturgy and teaching on the Lord's Prayer (during Lent).
- Shower, Baptism, and Chrismation of St. John's alumni, Noel and Nini's son, Emiliane.
- Bridal Shower for St. John's Student President, Heathryn Berry.
